

Rules for Use of Mooresville Basketball Facilities, 2011-2012

Safety

1. Children must be closely supervised at all times.
2. No food or drink on or near playing surfaces.
3. Children are not permitted out of the gym area without adult supervision.
4. Children are not permitted on the stage or in concession area.
5. Emphasize to parents about close supervision of siblings, friends, etc.

Damages

1. Each coach should do a routine check of facilities prior to use and advise the scheduler of any concerns as soon as possible.
2. Unsupervised children can lead to facility damage. The coach and parents are responsible for any damage to the facilities.
3. Each coach should do a routine check of facilities after use and advise the scheduler of any concerns as soon as possible.

Cleanliness

1. Anything brought into the facility should be removed at the end of use. This includes bottles, cans, papers, clothing, etc.
2. Clean-up of bodily fluids can only be done by adults with proper training, supplies and equipment. Contact the scheduler if a spill of this nature occurs.

Facility Use

1. Drinking fountains and restrooms closest to the gym are the only ones to be used.
2. In the event the school needs to be closed down due to weather or other reasons, all practices will be canceled for that evening.
3. The facility is to be vacated at the end of your scheduled time. Unorganized use after practice times is the most common time for damage, accidents and injuries by both players and non-players. Move any necessary discussions outside of the facility to insure there is no unsupervised activity in the facility.

Access

1. Newby Dome: South doors
2. New Newby: West doors (#6)
3. Northwood: North (#2)
4. Waverly: West (#12 downstairs)
5. Armstrong: South (#9)
6. North Madison: East (#12)
7. Paul Hadley Middle School (#19)

Removal of Access

1. Coaches and teams will lose access to practice facilities upon second incident of violation of the above rules. A written warning will be issued upon the first incident.
2. Individuals can lose access immediately upon violation of the above rules. This includes coaches, players, parents, siblings, friends, etc.

The intention of these rules is to insure continued access for all league teams. Both basketball boards desire is to have as many children in Mooresville playing as much basketball as possible. Practice facilities in the Mooresville area are currently at a premium. Continued use of these facilities as well as justification and motivation to provide additional facilities will at least partly be determined by our upkeep and organized use of the current facilities.
